Notification

The 5th September, 2025

No. Plg (HPSN)/2025/766.— The Governor of Haryana is pleased to notify the **Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Antyodaya Parivar Suraksha Yojana (DAYALU-II)** Scheme to provide financial assistance to the residents of Haryana in case of accidental death/injury/ disability occurred due to dog bite /stray animal such as cows, bulls, oxen, donkeys, dogs, nilgai, buffaloes etc. and also include the wild and deserted animals as well. The scheme intends to cover all families registered under Parivar Pehchan Patra (PPP).

General:

- (a) **'Beneficiary'** means member(s) of a family having Haryana Family ID/ PPP number.
- (b) **'Claimant'** means the beneficiary (in case of permanent disability) or eligible relative (in case of death) on behalf of the beneficiary applying to claim the assistance amount under DAYALU-II.
- (c) **'DAYALU-II'** means Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Antyodaya Parivar Suraksha Yojana-II.
- (d) **'Accident'** mean death or disability occurred due to dog bite /stray animal such as cows, bulls, oxen, donkeys, dogs, nilgai, buffaloes etc
- (e) **'Stray cattle/animal'** means animal such as cows, bulls, oxen, donkeys, dogs, nilgai, buffaloes etc. and also include the wild, pet and deserted animals as well.
- (f) **'Permanent Disability'** means 70% or above permanent disability on account of accident as certified by the Medical Authority.
- (g) **'State'** means the State of Haryana.
- (h) **'Trust/HPSN'** means Haryana Parivar Suraksha Nyas.

Applicability:

The beneficiary/claimant in case of death/permanent disability (caused by accident) @ 70 % or above and having an annual family income less than Rs. 1.8 lakh as verified in Family Information Data Repository (FIDR) database may submit claim either in DAYALU-I or in DAYALU-II Scheme as per the eligibility.

Eligibility:

1. The benefits of assistance under the scheme will be made available to only the residents of Haryana having Family ID/Parivar Pehchan Patra (PPP) number.
2. The scheme will come into force from the date of notification in the official gazette and no claim under this scheme for the accidental death/injury/ disability occurred prior to the date of issuance of this notification will be entertained. Date of incident will be the determining date of the scheme notification.

- The earlier notification dated 25.05.2023 and 09.11.2023 notified under DAYALU-II scheme will cease to exist after 90 days of date of notification dated 5th September 2025. No claim under earlier notification dated 25.5.2023 & 09.11.2023 will be entertained after 90 days of date of issuance of this notification.
3. In case of dogbite the compensation will be given subject to fulfilling the following condition:-
- Should be bitten or attacked by a stray/ pet dog and.
 - The attack occurred in a public place and.
 - Not provoked the animal to attack and.
 - Suffered physical injuries owing to the stray/pet dog attack.

Financial Assistance:

The scheme will provide the below mentioned assistance which would vary depending on the age of the beneficiary:-

A. In case of Death/ Disability (above 70% i.e permanent disability)

- Upto 12 years - Rs.1 lakh.
- above 12 years and upto 18 years- Rs.2 lakh
- above 18 years and upto 25 years- Rs.3 lakh
- above 25 years and upto 45 years -Rs. 5 lakh
- above 45 years- Rs. 3 lakh.

B. In case of Disability (Below 70%)

C. In case of Injury

1. In case Injury - Minor Injury not causing permanent disability - Fixed compensation of Rs.10,000/-.
2. Injury in case of dog bite: The compensation amount shall be at a minimum of Rs.10,000/- per teeth mark and where the flesh has been pulled off the skin, it shall be a minimum of Rs.20,000/- per "0.2 cm" of wound in case of dog bite.

District Level Committee:

A Committee in each District with the following members is constituted to determine the compensation to be paid on account of a claim made with respect to an accident/incident caused due to stray cattle/animal with such definition would include the animals such as cows, bulls, oxen, donkeys, dogs, nilgai, buffaloes etc. and also include the wild, pet and deserted animals as well:-

- Deputy Commissioner of the concerned District - Chairperson
- Superintendent of Police - Member
- Sub Divisional Magistrate of the concerned area - Member
- The District Transport Officer - Member
- Representative of the Chief Medical Officer - Member
- Planning Officer/District Statistical Officer - Member Secretary

Additional Members:

The Committee shall associate following as Member on case to case basis:-

- District Development and Panchayats Officer, (where the cases relating to the accident/incidents are reported to be in a Panchayats area).
- The District Forest Officer, (where the cases relating to the accident/incidents have taken place on account of any wild animal).
- The Executive Engineer, PWD (B&R) (where the incidents/accidents due to stray/wild animal have taken place on the State Roads/State Highways).
- Additional Commissioner/Executive Officer/Secretary of the Municipal Corporations/Committees (where it relates to the Local Self Government/notified area under Municipal law).
- The Project Director/ his Nominee and the Concessionaire/Authorized person of Concessionaire, if any, (where the accident/incidents happen on National Highways).
- The Executive Officer or his nominee of the implementing Department (where the incidents/accidents are reported to have taken place at the site of a project being implemented/carried out under some scheme of the Government).

Functions/responsibilities/powers of the Committee:-

- (a) To determine the compensation considering the nature of accident, actual cause of accident, contributory negligence if any, degree of injury etc.
- (b) The Committee will meet as per requirement considering the number of pending cases and the time limit in each District.
- (c) Quorum: Not less than 50% member shall form a quorum.
- (d) To establish the genuineness of the claim and identity of the claimant(s), the Committee may seek any further witnesses, evidences or documents from the claimant(s), as deems necessary, for deciding/determining the claim.
- (e) In case of Injury/Disability occurred by pet, then the Committee must give opportunity of hearing to the owner of the pet.
- (f) The Committee is bound by the maximum limits of the compensation as prescribed in the DAYALU-II scheme while declaring the award.
- (g) The Committee will recommend the Award within a period of 120 days of the claims being filed before it along with complete requisite documents. In case the claim is devoid of merit, the rejection of the claim shall also be passed by the Committee within 120 days.
- (h) The Committee may apportion the compensation between two or more departments where the involvement is of one or more such departments.

Claim Procedure:

1. The claim shall be filed by beneficiary/claimant through the online portal of the scheme <https://dapsy.finhry.gov.in> for assistance within 90 days of accident by filling an application form furnishing all the necessary details and required documents. One time relaxation is granted for the petitioners of CWP-22904 of 2016 plus 192 writ petitions which are disposed vide common judgment dated 18.08.2023 & plaintiffs of pending Civil Court cases on this issue filed before the date of issuance of this notification to the extent that they may submit fresh applications within 3 months from the date of issue of notification.
2. The victim shall submit the following documents online with the claim :-
 - I. In case of Death**
 - (a) Death certificate
 - (b) Copy of FIR/DDR indicating accident caused due to stray cattle/animal/dog bite.
 - II. In case of Disability**
 - (a) Disability certificate duly issued by concerned District Chief Medical Officer/Medical Board issued after the implementation of the scheme showing percentage of disability on account of incident/accident caused due to stray cattle/animal/dog bite.
 - (b) Hospital discharge summary.
 - (c) Copy of FIR/DDR indicating accident caused due to stray cattle/animal/dog bite.

- (d) Evidentiary documents/ proof establishing disability caused by animal attack/bite.
- III. In case of Injury**
- (a) Copy of the treatment of Hospital
- (b) Evidentiary documents/ proof establishing injury caused by animal attack/bite.
- (c) Proof of the dog attack by taking photos of the wounds, torn clothes and other evident signs owing to the attack.
- (d) Copy of FIR/DDR indicating injury due to accident caused due to stray cattle/ animal/dog bite.
3. To establish the genuineness of the claim and identity of the claimant(s), the deciding authority may seek any further documents from the claimant(s), as he deems necessary, for settlement of claim.
4. All the assistance payments shall be made in the bank account registered in the PPP database or through Aadhaar based seeded bank accounts. The data of bank account/Aadhaar number will also be taken from Family Information Data Repository (FIDR) database and further the bank will transfer the same to the bank account/Aadhaar seeded account.
5. In case of death, the assistance amount shall be paid
- A. In case Member of family is deceased then assistance will be given:**
- Head of the Family (HOF).
- B. In case Head of Family is deceased then assistance will be given:**
- Eldest of the family below the age of 60 years.
- In case no elder family member is below the age of 60 years then the family member immediate above the age of 60 years.
- C. In case no family member is alive after the death in the family then no assistance will be paid.**
- D. In case the alive family members are below the age of 18 years then the assistance will be paid only at the time of any member attaining the age above 18 years.**
6. In case of injury/disability, the assistance amount shall be paid to the beneficiary in his/her bank account registered in the PPP database or bank account linked to the Aadhaar number.
7. The details of the Award announced by the Committee and the compensation paid by the concerned department will be entered in the scheme portal.
8. In case assistance is sanctioned by suppressing true information or making wrong claim or on the basis of wrong information given by the claimant in the claim form then the assistance amount will be recoverable along with interest @ 12% per annum. - An online undertaking to this effect needs to be accepted by the applicant.
9. No claim made by the beneficiary/claimant shall be entertained after a period of 90 days from the date of occurrence of the incident/accident.

Nodal Agency:

The Nodal Agency for the DAYALU-II scheme will be Haryana Parivar Suraksha Nyas (HPSN), Government of Haryana. The Chief Executive Officer, Haryana Parivar Suraksha Nyas shall be overall in charge of the scheme and necessary instructions in respect to its proper enforcement and accounting procedure will be issued by HPSN from time to time.

Compensation to be paid:

Compensation as awarded by the Committee is to be paid by the Nodal Agency of the scheme i.e. Haryana Parivar Suraksha Nyas (HPSN) who is the overall in-charge of the scheme within a period of 6 weeks of the receipt of copy of the Award passed by the Committee and thereafter the same will be recovered from the defaulting Agencies/ Instrumentalities of the Union or State and the private persons, if any as mentioned above.

The detailed Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for implementation of the scheme are being issued separately.
